Racing ticket: £45 (£47 online, £50 on the day) per person which includes Sunday track time, Saturday camping and entertainment. Only one car per member. Members may add one additional driver, they do not have to be a VHRA member, but must pay the full price of £45. A driver can be added on the day, but there will be a signing on fee of £25 and they must hold a full weekend pass. Weekend Spectator ticket: £25 (£27 online, £30 on the day) per person, includes Saturday camping and entertainment. Sunday Daytime Spectator ticket: £15 (£16 online, £17 on the day) per person. Children 16 and under go free, but must be accompanied by an adult. ID may be required. Racing at the Vintage Nationals is open exclusively to VHRA members and their eligible vehicles. Weekend Spectator and Sunday Spectator tickets are available to all. Pre-entry is advised due to limited numbers and tickets are cheaper. Pre-entry closes 27th April. Bookings can be made by post or online at the VHRA website. When using this form, payment by cheque is preferred. If you do not have a cheque book we will accept a PayPal payment to info@vhra.co.uk, but a completed booking form must be sent in the post. There is a surcharge of £2 per ticket for PayPal payment and please be sure to quote your membership number on the payment. No form is required if you book online, there is however a small fee for doing so. No pets allowed.

COMPETING CAR DETAILS

The strip will be open on Sunday 6th May from 9.30am till 5pm. Vehicles must be VHRA eligible and be owned by the member making the booking. If cars do not meet VHRA rules at the event, they will be excluded from racing. A safety helmet that is fit for purpose is compulsory for all competitors. Exceptions to this rule are street cars running under 110mph. Helmets are compulsory in all open top vehicles regardless of speed. Roll cages and harnesses are strongly recommended for all vehicles running quicker than 12 seconds over a quarter mile. Drivers legs and arms must be covered. Gloves are to be worn. Seat belt must be fitted and a fixed fire extinguisher carried. Arm Restraints are mandatory for all open top and windowless vehicles. Windows must be fully up when on the dragstrip. A catch can should be fitted to the radiator overflow. Vehicles cannot run if they have leak of any description. Full bonnet required for non-vintage appearing engines. Race cars are allowed. Battery must be secured. Race numbers must be applied to rear of vehicle and clearly visible. Cars may be subject to a safety inspection. Drivers must present a full driving licence and sign on for racing. No passengers are to be carried. Refer to race classes before completing form as race numbers are issued prior to event.
